The overall objective of the project is to provide technical assistance to state institutions in improving policies against illegal migration through the drafting of a Study Report.

The specific objectives of the project are:

- 1. Preparing and handing in proposals on reviewing the law and strategy in the field of irregular migration
- 2. Preparing and handing in proposals for approximation of working documents such as manuals, guides, etc. according to EU standards and criteria
- 3. Handing in proposals for a better execution of the legal and strategic frameworks through the application of changes in the institutional and administrative aspects
- 4. Handing in proposals on the need for efforts to influence the phenomenon of smuggling of migrants from Albania to the European Union member countries.

The project consists in the drafting of a Study Report that analyzes data on human trafficking and migration to differentiate between them and to present public policies on these phenomena.
