The overall objective of the project is to contribute to the provision of psycho-social and legal services to 150 illegal migrants for a period of 6 months in order to prevent smuggling and respect their rights.

The specific objectives are:

- 1. To contribute through raising the awareness of and informing 150 migrants about the dangers and consequences that come from illegal migration, through the media.
- 2. Encourage inter-institutional response to provide effective services and case management through multifunctional roundtables
- 3. Provide psycho-social, legal and entertainment services in order to alleviate the traumas carried by women, children and people with disabilities.

The results that are intended to be achieved are:

- a) 3 roundtables to identify the needs of migrants, missing services and capacity building of human resources with representatives of the Municipality, media, Directorate of Migration and Border, DFS, CARITAS, Police Directorate.
- b) Production of 5 chronicles, 1 media campaign, 1 TV show and 2 migrant stories
- c) 400 leaflets in order to inform migrants on legal and psycho-social services
- d) 50 migrants supported through legal services
- e) 150 migrants supported with counseling service, psychological service assistance and in the development of various entertainment activities, sports games, etc.
