The overall objective of the project is to increase youth participation and engagement in the political process and parliamentary elections 2020.

The specific objectives of the project are:

1. Awareness-raising for the first time in schools and universities on the importance of voting, governance and the political system;
2. Promoting the debate on the inclusion of young people in the electoral platforms of the main political parties through democratic education.

The expected results that are intended to be achieved are:

1. Direct information of 200 young people, first time voters on the importance of voting and the negative phenomena in elections that they risk facing through 6 sessions "Let's talk about voting";
2. Informing and raising awareness of about 20,000 young people through an awareness campaign on social networks;
3. Young people being more informed about political offers, less indifferent on Election Day and more interested in the political life of the country and political parties being more attentive to the promises and governing programs for young people in the election campaign.
